

## 5D4N Sydney and Farmstay (AUSSYD)

### ITINERARY

#### DAY 1: ARRIVAL SYDNEY – FARMSTAY (L/D)

Upon arriving, we will make our way to the farm for our farmstay experience. It is the perfect opportunity to experience the Aussie hospitality first-hand. Depending on the focus of the host, guests can participate in various farm activities such as feeding of farm animals, collecting chicken eggs and having them cooked for you, picking or planting seasonal fruits, berries and vegetables, stargazing at the amazing myriad of stars, spotting native wildlife amidst the rural environment and admire the picturesque countryside. This is an educational and enriching experience for all ages. Tonight, enjoy the homemade 3-course dinner prepared by the host.

#### DAY 2: FARMSTAY – SYDNEY (B)

After breakfast, transfer from farm to hotel in Sydney. Spend your free time exploring the city.

Alternatively, you may take the Bridge Climb to the top of the Sydney Harbour Bridge at your own expense and enjoy wonderful panoramic views of the city.

#### DAY 3: SYDNEY – HALF DAY CITY – BONDI BEACH (B)

Today, set off on a half day city tour to some of the most beautiful places in Sydney. This tour includes a Historic Rocks walking tour of “Sydney’s birthplace”, the Sydney Opera House, Hyde Park, St. Mary’s Cathedral, Parliament House, Art Gallery of NSW, Royal Botanic Gardens, Sydney Town Hall, Sydney Tower and Darling Harbour. Visit Mrs Macquarie’s Chair to get superb views of the harbour and the city’s skyline, The Royal Australian Naval Base, Garden Island Kings Cross, Sydney’s ‘hot spot’ the Affluent Double Bay, and the Vaucluse Famous Bondi Beach. The tour also covers the historic, trendy Paddington Bustling Chinatown and many other places of interest.

#### DAY 4: FULL DAY TOUR (B)

This morning, explore the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Blue Mountains. Inhale crisp, clean, fresh mountain air and gaze at the distant blue horizons overlooking deep ravines with rainforest carpeting the valley floor. Waterfalls, sleepy hamlets and the rich warm smell of the Australian bush make this a very special place for every visitor. Enjoy an afternoon at Featherdale Wildlife Park – one of Australia’s largest private collections of native animals and birdlife and end the day with a relaxing cruise down the Parramatta River and Sydney Harbour. Tour concludes at Darling Harbor or Circular Quay.

Or go on a tour around the nation’s capital - a purpose-built city that is ultra-modern with imposing architecture, and yet with a touch of rural charm of lakeside, gardens and open spaces. This metropolitan is where the Parliament is at and is also home to impressive national monuments, museums and galleries. Highlights of the tour include visiting the historic township of Berrima in the Southern Highlands for morning tea (own expense), enjoying the panoramic views of Canberra and the surroundings of the summit of Mt Ainslie. Visit the Australian War Memorial with a guided tour. Go on another guided tour of the new hands on, state of the art National Museum or the National Gallery of Australia (subject to current exhibitions) to have a complete experience. Visit the spectacular billion dollar Parliament House with a guide and if you’re lucky, you may see the upper or lower Houses of Parliament in session. See “The Lodge” – residence of Australia’s Prime Minister, and view the many embassies and foreign diplomatic residences.

#### DAY 5: SYDNEY – SINGAPORE (B)

Free at leisure until departing for the airport for your flight home.
